

**TOWN OF MORRISTOWN
SELECTBOARD MEETING MINUTES**

AUGUST 20, 2001

Chair, Brian Greenia called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM in the Municipal Conference Room.

GUESTS

CONSERVATION COMMISSION:

Kathleen O'Neill, chair of the Conservation Commission, addressed the Selectboard in response to a letter sent to Commission members. Kathleen wanted to clarify the role of the Commission in conjunction with the Selectboard, and explain the emails concerning the Bypass. The "Letter to the Editor" regarding the Bypass launched telephone calls from concerned citizens who have worked on the Bypass for more than 20 years. She feels any misunderstandings have been cleared, and the Commission plans to have better communication with the Selectboard and Planning Commission in the future. Kathleen ended by giving a list of the projects that the Commission is involved with.

The Selectboard acknowledged receipt of a letter from Peggy Struhsacker regarding the Commission's interest in the Millard Zeisberg property.

OLD BUSINESS

BIKE SIGNS:

Jim Neuland had previously requested an ordinance requiring cyclists to ride single file on Randolph Road. After much consideration, the Board chose not to adopt an ordinance they felt would be impossible to enforce.

MINUTES:

On a motion by Lee Sturtevant, seconded by Jim Paige, the Board unanimously approved the minutes of August 6, 2001.

APPROVED

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On a motion by Jim Paige, seconded by Lee Sturtevant, the Board unanimously voted to approve the 4th Annual Corn Roast at the Oxbow on Friday, August 24, 2001.

ZONING VIOLATIONS:

Paul and Ken Sweetser reviewed Zoning permit violations with the Board. Ken advised all correspondence is in process to correct these violations. A suggestion to charge penalties on permits not applied for, before starting construction, was made.

ALPINE RIDGE SEPTIC VIOLATION:

Ken Sweetser reported that the Alpine Ridge Corp. failed septic system, referenced in the June 11, 2001 Board of Health Hearing, has been corrected. No further action by the Board is required.

MRS/COPLEY TRUST:

The Selectboard requested research done on "the possibility of charging for ambulance services", at their July 23, 2001 meeting. After digging in the archives and conversing with Richard Sargent, it was determined that the MRS building and service are the responsibility of the Town of Morristown, and they can charge for it's services to help defray the costs of operation, if so desired. No action was taken.

SEMINAR:

The 2001 Town Fair & Field Day on September 27, 2001 was discussed.

On a motion by Jim Paige, seconded by Lee Sturtevant, the Board voted to appoint Don Anderson as Morristown's representative to the Town Fair.

SIDEWALK PROJECT:

The next Selectboard meeting will be at the Tegu Building Conference Room on Tuesday, September 4, 2001 to allow for an informational meeting on the Morristown STP WALK (4) S sidewalk project.
