



SELECTBOARD MEETING OF JUNE 5, 2019

Bob Beeman called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

II. VICIOUS DOG HEARING

Town Administrator Dan Lindley talked about the complaint received by the victim Fredrick Jones. Fredrick was walking near the Police Station parking lot when a Rottweiler named Diamond owned by James Bradley came running towards him and grabbed and bit his arm. Mr. Jones sought medical attention at Copley.

James Bradley Owner of Diamond recounted his version. The dogs got out around 2 am. He spent some time looking for them but was not successful in locating them. The dogs returned to his residence around 6 am. He discovered that they got through a weak part in his fence. Mr. Bradley has since fixed the fence. His dogs have never had an incidence like this. Both dogs are up to date on their rabies vaccination and are due to be registered with the Town on Friday. Mr. Bradley is a new resident to Morrisville.

The recommendation of the Animal Control officer is to require the dogs to be in his control at all times and must be on a leash when off his property. Diamond is also required by law to be quarantined for 10 days. Brian Kellogg, Animal control officer suggested that Diamond be quarantined on his property.

Todd Thomas, Health Officer spoke about the property quarantine. He thought that would be fine as long as everyone was in agreement. Todd will check in with Mr. Bradley in 10 days.

Motion made by Brian Kellogg that the dog known as Diamond owned by James Bradley must be on a leash and in the control of an adult at all times when off the property. Diamond also must be quarantined for 10 days as mandated by Vermont State Law. Motion seconded by Chris Towne Motion carried. (3/0)

III. LIQUOR CONTROL

Motion made by Chris Towne to enter as Board of Liquor Control. Motion seconded by Brian Kellogg. Motion carried. (3/0)

Motion made by Brian Kellogg to approve the request for outside consumption for RockArt Brewery. Motion seconded by Chris Towne. Motion carried. (3/0)

Motion made by Chris Towne to come out of the Board of Liquor Control. Motion seconded by Brian Kellogg. Motion carried. (3/0)

Motion made by Chris Towne to adjourn the meeting at 4:50 PM, motion seconded by Brian Kellogg. Motion carried. (3/0)
