SELECTBOARD MEETING

The Chair opened the meeting of the **BOARD OF HEALTH** in the Municipal Conference Room at 6:30 p.m. David Godfrey was available to discuss a failed Septic System at the Sam Jewett property on Bridge Street. The home is in the village therefore David spoke with Richard Sargent regarding the possibility of hooking onto the village system. Mr. Sargent advised David that the system could be hooked onto the Village system at the home-owners expense. The Jewett's stated that this will be a financial hardship for them therefore Brian Greenia advised them to contact CVCAC for advice in their situation. The Town would have funds available with a payment plan and a lien would be put on the property. Lee Sturtevant made the motion seconded by Phil Locke to require the Jewett septic system be in compliance within 30 days. discussion; the Board would like the Jewett's to notify Don Ward at the Sewage Treatment Plant of the situation and their plans. Passed David Godfrey also advised the Board that the leach field at the Steve Mayer property is surfacing. Mr. Mayer has been sent a certified letter but a return receipt has not been received as of yet.

Ken Grimes made the motion seconded by Phil Locke to adjourn the meeting of the Board of Health and open the meeting of the Selectboard at 6:42 pm. Passed.

MINUTES: Lee Sturtevant made the motion seconded by Steve Leach to approve the minutes of the May 18, 1998 meeting. Passed.

AA REPORT: Maria stated that she may have to work more than 60 hours per pay period while working on 911 and Delinquent Taxes along with the general office duties. The extra hours will only be when necessary. Would the Board approve the payment of over 60 hours or should I use the time as vacation during the Summer. Using the time as vacation would be fine with me. All agreed. Jeff Foss has asked to be reimbursed for seven tires that were left at the landfill road at a cost of \$16.10. The Board agreed to reimburse Jeff with the understanding that in the future the Town will not be responsible.

GUESTS: Larry Jourdan was present to discuss the generator at Peoples Academy. The work is not in compliance with the State therefore Larry would like to correct the situation at his expense at the end of the school year.

Carroll Lawrence was present to discuss the Manosh Road. He doesn't feel the road should be named Manosh Road. Mr. Lawrence was given an application to name a private road. The application should be submitted to the Board at the June 15 meeting with the recommendation of a new name along with the signature of approval from all home owners on the road.

Albert & Gretchen Besser were in attendance to discuss their disapproval of the Tonelli private air strip on the Stagecoach Road. Mrs. Besser explained that they bought their property on the Stagecoach Road in 1968 and later purchased the Valley View Farm in 1996. The Besser's have many concerns regarding the airstrip and the effects it will have on animal life, scenery, and safety issues.

Mrs. Evelyn Redlich also disapproves of the airstrip and she has concerns of the noise level and safety issues. She is also concerned about the lack of regulations. Brian Greenia suggested a warned hearing to discuss the issues. Lee Sturtevant made the motion to have a Warned Public Hearing June 22, 1998 at 7:00pm to discuss the airstrip. Ken Grimes seconded the motion. Ken, Lee, Phil, and Brian in favor. Steve opposed. Passed.

Don Anderson was in attendance to discuss 911 and road names. The road that was once known as the Manosh development has some confusion as to whether the road name is Long Branch or Lazy Branch Circle. Mr. Anderson has done some research as to when the road was originally named and it appears that the road was named Long Branch Circle. Steve Leach made the motion seconded by Lee Sturtevant to keep the road name Long Branch Circle. Passed. An application was received from the Sand Ridge road association to name the extension of that road Sand Ridge Acres. Brian made the motion seconded by Lee Sturtevant to name the road Sand Ridge Acres. discussion; The Fire Chief, Police Chief along with Bill Moulton believe the name of the road would be too closely associated with Sand Ridge Road therefore causing confusion in an emergency situation. Should the road be named Sand Ridge Acres? Brian-yes, Steve-no, Ken-no, Phil-no, Lee-no. Don had been notified that the private drive at the end of Cote' Hill had not been named. The road was developed by Mr. Salvas. Lee
