

# **SELECTBOARD MEETING MINUTES**

## **MAY 29, 2000**

Meeting was called to order at 6:08pm.

### **HIGHWAY REPORT:**

Department received new paint for the crosswalks. Crew has been spreading chloride and sand however had to stop due to the rain. There was discussion regarding requests from owners of placing lines, etc. within Town right of ways. It was decided the Town should have a policy for this issue, as requests are more frequent. Don A. will gather information on this.

### **POLICE:**

Calls are increasing – 205 calls with 1 detox. Firearms training will be on June 1<sup>st</sup>. Jerry will be on vacation for 2 weeks – Eric & Ryan are both back from training. One cruiser needs windshield repair. Discussion of previous F.D. personnel issue – Board agrees to file charges and prosecute. Richard will follow up with paperwork. COPS program was discussed. The Board suggested a letter of understanding with the school be drafted. Ryan has already been working on a policy/draft. Richard will bring in to the Board for review. Don made the motion seconded by Brian to sign the COPS 2000 Grant Program. Passed. SL-opposed. Richard will be getting an estimate for replacement of walkway lights in front of the station – one was damaged in the windstorm however it is time for replacement of all.

### **FIRE:**

Wally submitted a revised request sheet for purchases. Items included new hose, uniforms, machinery & equipment, chairs and rebuild of 14W1 – all within the budget. Don made the motion seconded by Brian to approve the expenditures as listed out of the current budget. Passed. The air activated engine valve on Engine 2 needs a rebuild kit. The W&L property is still on schedule to be burned on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Manufacturers of infrared system will be here on June 10<sup>th</sup> – Wally is hoping to have a system purchased by July 1<sup>st</sup>. One firefighter sprained his back at the Demars fire and will be out for 4 weeks.
