**1. Discuss the financial impact of FY 25/26 budget due to zoning vacancy**

Laura Streets was concerned that the previous Zoning Administrator/Planning Administrator's salary was beneath the range needed for a replacement considering that the budget had been finalized. Don noted that the budget included the remaining unused salary for this year and the current budgeted amount. This should cover the cost of the consultant and the new hire. Laura wanted to know if the budget represented just salary or included compensation. Brent noted during the hiring process salaries were estimated with the community standard for the position and included many variables such as insurance costs. Budgeting is a plan, not a commitment added George. There are no contingency costs added to a budget. Every variable in budgeting will be considered and balanced with the actual figures. He felt that this was a good tight budget. Chris and Richard agreed with George. Chris added that he and George worked on the budget for months and new positions in EMS and the Highway Department have already happened with no ramifications. He doesn't feel that decisions should be affected by fear. The prevailing decision was that the budget could stand as it is.
