First Order of Business:

Teleconference with Paul Markowitz -- the Steering Committee discussed preparations for the Community Forum to be held on November 6th. There are some problems with the banner and it has not been erected over the downtown intersection. SJ who is responsible for the banner was not in attendance. JC will schedule radio spots with WLVB the week of the Forum as well as the week of the Charette. Paul will follow up with news coverage in the Transcript. Everyone has distributed posters and they are up around town. Volunteers are still needed to facilitate the day of the event. Barb Farr is coordinating facilitators.

Second Order of Business:

Rob Nesbitt gave an update on the Community Forum postal insert. Approximately 2800 inserts will go out on 10/27/99 to all Morrisville postal patrons.

Third Order of Business:

Frank Huard asked for an update/summary of the November 6th Forum. GR and Ken Sweetser gave an overview of the days' events, and the purpose of gathering information. Frank Huard expressed pessimism over the success of the project. Brian Grenia emphasized that many past projects/efforts failed due to a lack of communication or dedication on the part of the participants. Brian stated that the Planning Commission involvement will help avoid a repeat of past problems. He also stated that all community boards should share their minutes with each other and coordinate cooperative efforts.

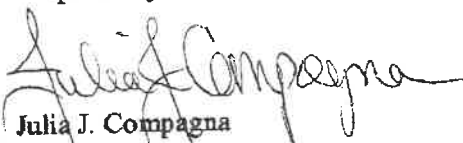
The meeting adjourned at 8:05 PM.
