

**MORRISTOWN/MORRISVILLE
PLANNING COMMISSION
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Minutes of October 15, 2002

Julia called the meeting to order at 7:20 PM.

Members continued discussion from the previous meeting on Land Use. Bill B, Bill H, and Julia felt this language should be fairly general and not specify guidelines for a specific area, such as Mud City. A consensus of the board was repeated that the Route 100 corridor be preserved, village in-fill should be encouraged as well as connectivity and infill for commercial, residential, and industrial uses between the village and the north end. The Land Use section should also include language regarding a healthy mix overall of agricultural, residential, and commercial/industrial development. Minimize access.

For Plan Implementation, it should identify board tasks for the 5-year window covered by the plan. Planning Commission should work on Zoning Bylaw revisions. Village Trustees should evaluate improved efficiencies of village infrastructure.

Julia shared a summary of the Sustainable Jobs grant information packet.

Approval of the October 1 minutes was deferred due to a lack of a quorum present at that meeting.

The next meeting will be on November 5, 2002 at the Water & Light Department building, to review proposed revisions to various sections of the Town Plan.

Kelly moved to adjourn and Bill seconded the motion. All voting in favor of the motion, the meeting was adjourned at 8:55 PM.
