BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING

The Board of Civil Authority of the Town of Morristown convened the warned meeting at the Conference Room of the Municipal Building, 18 Lower Main Street, in said town on Tuesday, the 8th day of October, 2002 at 6:00 P.M.

Chairman Favreau opened the Meeting at 6:05 P.M.

1. Clerk Wilson updated the Board on the condition of member Don Anderson who suffered a stroke.
2. Pursuant to Title 17 V.S.A., § 2144b the board reviewed the changes made to the voter checklist by the Town Clerk. There was no discussion of the changes.
3. Pursuant to Title 24 V.S.A., § 1535, the board considered abatement of real estate and personal property taxes assessed. **(See attached.)**
4. There was no old business.
5. New business:
 - a. On a motion by Brian Greenia, with a second by Theresa Breault, the board voted affirmatively to set the hours for the polls from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM for the General Election on 11-5-02. Board members scheduled times to work the polls. Pairs of Justices agreed to deliver ballots to shut-ins if requested.
 - b. The ballot showing the proposed slate of Justices of the Peace for the 11-5-02 election was presented. Current JP's were advised that their present terms will end 1-31-03.

With no other business to come before the board, Ken Campbell moved for adjournment, seconded by Peg Lambert. Motion carried, and the meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.
