

MORRISTOWN BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT -- MINUTES
LRSWMD WARNED HEARING
October 7, 1994

BOARD MEMBERS PRESENT: Acting Chairman Ralph Wiltshire; Theresa Breault; Ida Mae Anderson; Jean Wickart and Paul Trudell, Rose Lambert.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR: Kenneth Sweetser

The meeting was called to order at 7:33 P.M. by Acting Chairman Ralph Wiltshire, who advised this was the Final Warned Public Hearing concerning the LAMOILLE REGIONAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT'S application for a Landfill and Recycling Center; that the purpose of this Hearing was:

- 1) To review all materials and information that had been presented to the Board;
- 2) To formally close process of presenting evidence from June 22, 1994 to today's date, October 7, 1994.
- 3) To recess this Hearing to a Deliberative session, in which the Board of Adjustment has 45 days to make a decision regarding the information presented to the Board.

Don Marsh, Project Engineer, advised there were two (2) documents in evidence that were not relevant to this application, being:

- a) Forestry Management Plan on the Farrand land that Mr. Manosh will maintain, consisting of 60.7 acres;
- b) Letter from Hyde Park pertaining to the Environmental Board, whereby Manosh Corporation asked to amend the gravel pit's extraction rate.

Mr. Marsh also stated that the 'stock-pile' plans have been relocated from the field into the woods. The 'stock-pile' will go to Ferland Pit for use or reclamation. That being the 'stock-pile' not needed on site.

The adjoining property owners in attendance voiced their objections, stating this stock-pile will then be located in the Town of Hyde Park, VT and that the people of Hyde Park should be made aware of this relocation.

Mr. Tricomi advised there are numerous unsolved problems, being:

- 1) The Deer Herd issue;
- 2) The Road problem;
- 3) Leaching and other serious problems.

Theresa made the motion to close testimony on this application. Jean seconded. All in favor.

Theresa made the motion to move to Deliberative Session tonight at 8:00 P.M. (10/07/94), Ida Mae seconded. All in favor.
