**October 5, 2021**  
**Annual Meeting Minutes**

Present: Gloria Wing, Lee Sturtevant, Joie Marshall, Rich Jacobs, Mark Faith, Tina Sweet, Paula Beattie

Joie called the meeting to order at 5:30PM. Minutes of May 19, 2021 meeting were reviewed and, upon motion made by Gloria and seconded by Lee, passed unanimously.

The next item on the agenda was election of officers. There being no one else to step into the positions, Lee proposed all officers remain the same. Gloria seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Lee wanted to make it known that this would be his last year serving on the board.

Joie presented the proposed FY 22-23 budget for review. Upon motion made by Lee, seconded by Gloria, the budget passed unanimously.

Rich Jacobs of Edward Jones presented a review of investments. Although interest rates are down, PVC's investments are doing reasonably well. Joie thanked Rich for his efforts and everyone agreed he is doing a great job.

Mark Faith advised that cremations now run as high as 90%. Officers had discussed having a designated area for cremains, offering 4'x4' lots with flush markers to make mowing easier. It was decided that a site visit should be made to determine the best location.

The current maps available are too small to be of any use. Gloria will determine the location of the survey materials prepared in the past. Then inquiries will be made as to securing larger, more readable maps for future use.

Gloria reported that Mike has a new zero turn mower which is working out well. The John Deere will be replaced next year. Once the water is turned off, Mike plans to address a bent spigot with the hope he can make the necessary repair. If that isn't possible, it will be necessary to hire someone to make the repair.

The overgrowth on the Congress Street end of the cemetery needs attention. Lee will contact Forester Fran Sladyk to secure recommendations on how we should proceed. He will also contact Mike Renaud regarding tree removal.

There being no further business, upon motion made by Lee, seconded by Gloria and voted unanimously, the meeting adjourned at 6:25PM.
