MINUTES OF BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING

The Board of Civil Authority within and for the Town of Morristown reconvened on Tuesday, the 20th day of September, 2007, at 6:15 PM at the Municipal Building Conference Room at 43 Portland Street, Morrisville in said town.

Members present: T. Hirschak, K. Campbell, D. Andrews, R. Bedell, D. Blake, T. Breault, S. Leach, M. Demars, S. Smith, S. Bryer, E. Wilson and M. A. Wilson.

Members absent: F. Favreau, S. Rooney, B. Kellogg, S. Bousquet, D. Yacovone and T. Yando.

Listers present: None.

Meeting opened at 6:30 PM by T. Hirschak, Chair. All BCA members were reminded that they are still under oath.

- I. Pursuant to the provisions of 32 V.S.A., Section 4404(b), the Board of Civil Authority heard grievances of persons, or other parties, who are aggrieved by the action of the Board of Listers and have timely filed their written appeals with the Town Clerk. Hearings will continue as scheduled with appellants until all aggrieved parties are heard.

Inspection Reports:

- A. On a motion, the board voted affirmatively to accept the report as presented by the inspection committee of the Wickart appeal #2007-12. On a motion by S. Smith with a second by K. Campbell, the BCA voted affirmatively to maintain the listers' assessment of \$717,100.
- B. Upon motion, the board voted affirmatively to accept the report as presented by the inspection committee of the Rooney appeal #2007-11. On a motion by E. Wilson with a second by P. Demars, the BCA voted affirmatively to maintain the listers' assessment of \$2,497,400.
