BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING

The Board of Civil Authority of the Town of Morristown convened the warned meeting at the Town Clerk's Office in said town on Monday, the 5th day of September, 2000, at 12:00 P.M.

Chairman Favreau opened the meeting at 12:00 P.M.

Pursuant to Title 17 V.S.A., Section 2142, the board met to revise the checklists for the Statewide Primary Election which will be held on Tuesday, September 12, 2000. It was moved by Don Anderson with a second by Peg Lambert to approve 68 additions as presented by the Town Clerk. All in favor, and the motion carried. It was moved by Steve Leach with a second by Theresa Breault to approve 19 deletions as presented by the Town Clerk. All in favor, and the motion carried (See lists attached.)

Pairs of JP's were selected for delivery of absentee ballots.

Scheduling of B.C.A. members was set for the Primary.

The booklet on Elections Perspectives 2000 was distributed. Discussion centered on how to explain to the voters about only voting on one ballot, even though they will receive two. BCA members were refreshed on the use of the vote tabulator.

The names of the Democratic and Republican candidates for Justice of the Peace, nominated by party caucus, was discussed. Clerk Wilson informed the JP's of a correction to the current "JP Guide".

With no other business to come before the board, Donald Anderson moved for adjournment. Steve Leach seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 12:15 P.M.
