Joy Chilton, Chairwoman of the Elmore Selectboard, facilitated the meeting.

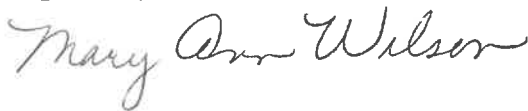
Pursuant to Title 17 V.S.A., Section 1905, the boards met to discuss and recommend jointly to the Legislative Apportionment Board by August 1, 2001, a proposal for the reapportionment of the House of Representatives for Morristown, Elmore and Wolcott. The three boards met as a group for discussion. The map of the proposed district was on display, and it was clear to everyone that Morristown would split from Stowe and become a two-member district with Elmore and Wolcott. Conversation about the pros and cons ensued. Then the boards broke into individual groups by towns, and were asked to report back to the larger group on their decision about the proposed reapportionment plan.

In its individual group, Morristown voted 7 members to 1, to support the two-member district as proposed by the Legislative Apportionment Board.

Upon returning to the larger group, the B. C. A.'s of Elmore, Morristown and Wolcott voted to support the two-member district as proposed by the Legislative Apportionment Board.

Meeting adjourned.
