BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING

The Board of Civil Authority of the Town of Morristown met at the Conference Room of the Municipal Building, 43 Portland Street in said town on Thursday, the 21st day of June 2007, at 5:30 P.M.

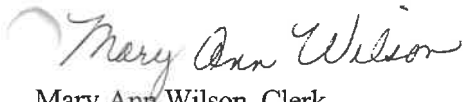
Listers present: Charles McArthur and Thomas Williams.

New Business:

1. Chairman Francis Favreau opened the meeting at 5:40 PM.
2. On a motion by Theresa Breault, with a second by Peg Demars, the B.C.A. voted Francis Favreau as chairman for the year ensuing.
3. On a motion by Theresa Breault, with a second by Ken Campbell, the B.C.A. voted Thomas Hirschak as chairman for the 2007 tax appeal hearings.
4. It is the duty of the Board of Civil Authority to designate polling places and hours (17 VSA § 2501) for Town and Town School District meetings and polling places for Federal and State elections. Upon motion by Theresa Breault with a second by Peg Demars, the board voted unanimously to continue to hold the Annual Town and School District meetings at the Peoples Academy Gym – traditional open meeting convening at 9:00 AM. For all meetings in which an Australian ballot is to be voted as well as in-person balloting for Federal and State elections, voting will take place at the Municipal Building at 43 Portland Street, Morrisville at a date and time as stated in warnings for meetings. The Municipal Building is handicapped accessible, and there is parking in the municipal parking lots. As a point of information, the PA High School Library and the VFW will no longer be used as polling places. This designation will remain in effect until amended by vote.
5. Abatement of real estate and personal property taxes assessed - Title 24 V.S.A § 1535
 - A. Request by Town Treasurer to abate small amounts due for tax reconciliation purposes: \$17.75
On a motion by Dawn Andrews with a second by Theresa Breault, the board voted affirmatively to abate \$17.75.
 - B. CIT Technology Financing: Parcel ID #90238
A mix up in the account led to a billing error. With a motion by Dawn Andrews and a second by Theresa Breault, the board abated \$38.22.
 - C. Lynnette Manning: Parcel ID #70074
Mobile home removed from town, but was not removed from the Grand List. Upon motion by Dawn Andrews and a second by Theresa Breault, the board abated \$92.70.
 - D. Jestra, Inc: Parcel ID #90113
Business sold, inventory removed, but value not removed from Grand List. Upon motion by
