Chair Report

- (1) Green-Up: 44 people signed up and participated in the town Green-Up effort. The school took 50 bags. A dump was cleaned up on Church Hill Road. The Lamoille River Anglers were also active along the river.
- (2) Town Forest Signage: The three signs were completed by the Lamoille Union HS Tech Center. The total cost for materials was \$67.50 for the signs (excluding posts and mounting hardware). Mike Brown was the teacher in charge. The class would be willing to do more signage for Clark Park during the fall semester. A photo of the sign at the Beaver Meadow Trailhead is below. Jim will check with Forest and Parks and make sure the signs are okay to install with the state sign. Steve will check with the Town Highway department about installing the signs.
- (3) Ron attended the "Staying Connected" workshop and distributed literature from the group. Ron also met with the Johnson Conservation Commission and discussed the property lines of the Town Forest that abut Johnson. They discussed the Town Forest.
- (4) The head of the American Chestnut Foundation may want to visit the Town Forest in the future.
- (5) Ron presented the Town Forest window display. He will mount the maps on board and look at putting in the display in August. Ron also has a location map showing where the forest is in the Town which will go in the window.
