(2) Old Business:

Town Plan - The Select Board received a letter from the Planning Commission (PC) requesting that the MCC meet with the PC and review the MCC bylaws. Ron went to the PC meeting. The PC cited section VIIa of the bylaws requiring the MCC to inventory natural resources of the Town. Ron is talking with the Lamoille County Planning Commission about how to provide this information to the PC.

(3) New Business:

Clark Park – Ron gave Craig Myette and the Village Trustees a draft lease for Clark Park to review. Language describing the extent of the land and the difference between Clark Park and Clark Park extension was discussed. The group then did a site visit of the park.
