BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING

The Board of Civil Authority of the Town of Morristown convened the warned meeting at the Conference Room of the Municipal Building, 18 Lower Main Street, in said town on Tuesday, the 6th day of May, 2003 at 6:00 P.M.

Members present: Ken Campbell, Ed Wilson, Theresa Breault, Jane Greene, Thomas Hirschak, Margaret Lambert, Brian Greenia, Steve Leach, Brian Kellogg, Dave Yacovone and Mary Ann Wilson.

Listers present: Lynn Miller, Francis Favreau and David Sanborn.

Chairman Favreau opened the Meeting at 6:06 P.M.

1. Pursuant to Title 24 V.S.A., § 1535, the board considered abatement of real estate and personal property taxes assessed.

For FY 2001-2002:

- a. On a motion by Tom Hirschak, with a second by Peg Lambert, the BCA voted affirmatively to abate the 2001-2002 property taxes for the Morrisville Beverage Store - ID# 90145, in the amount of \$48.04 under criteria 4 of the abatement statutes. Personal property was removed from town, but the listers were not notified.
>Principal = \$44.52 and Interest = 3.52

- b. On a motion by Ed Wilson, with a second by Theresa Breault, the BCA voted affirmatively to abate the 2001-2002 property taxes of Robert Thomas – ID# 70024, in the amount of \$269.92 under criteria 2 and 3 of the abatement statutes. The property has been abandoned, and all efforts to locate Mr. Thomas have failed.
>Principal = \$217.58, Penalty = 30.52, Interest = 17.40, Other = 4.42

For FY 2002-2003:

- a. On a motion by Ed Wilson, with a second by Theresa Breault, the BCA voted affirmatively to abate the 2002-2003 property taxes of Robert Thomas – ID# 70024, in the amount of \$242.72 under criteria 2 and 3 of the abatement statutes. The property has been abandoned, and all efforts to locate Mr. Thomas have failed. The BCA also instructed the listers to remove the property from the Grand List.
>Principal = \$235.64, Interest = 7.08

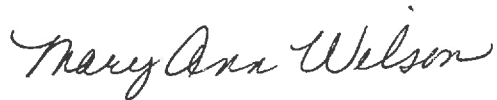
- b. On a motion by Ed Wilson, with a second by Theresa Breault, the BCA voted affirmatively to abate a portion of the 2002-2003 property taxes of Judith St. Aubin – ID# 21039, under criteria 5 of the abatement statutes. A garage had been torn down, and the listers were never notified. Error will be corrected in the 2003 Grand List. The BCA directed that a refund be issued in the amount of \$99.72.
>Principal only = \$99.72.

Under other business, Clerk Wilson advised the BCA that a revote on the School Budget would be held on Tuesday, May 27, 2003. The BCA will have to be in attendance to work the polls from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM

Lister Lynn Miller updated the BCA on the reappraisal timeline. Notices of re-evaluation will go out in early summer, and grievance hearings will be held. BCA appeals will probably start in the early fall.

With no other business to come before the board, Ken Campbell moved for adjournment, seconded by Theresa Breault. Motion carried, and the meeting adjourned at 7:00 PM.
