The recording Sec.'s report from last Sept. was read and accepted.

The Pres. passed out the meetings agenda and the 2003-2004 Budget review. All items were presented, discussed and categorized.

In compliance with States' statutes Edward Hones of Morrisville is handling the Cemetery's Portfolio. Cost of this project has not been ascertained.

A motion made by Steven and seconded by Brian to allow the Pres. and Sec. to sign for the acceptance of the portfolio for the Assoc/

Gloria presented the estimates of the newly proposed water lines wherein Ken Grimes' bid was accepted. The Copley fund would pay \$15,000, and the Grimes will bequeath the Cemetery \$3000. It was noted that Allen Newton should record reference points.

A motion was made by Lee and seconded by Gloria that Mike have the Cub tractor repaired at Bornman & Greene. The Deere tractor to be serviced at LuteS, to be looked into by Steve and Mike.

Roof repairs for both cemetery bldgs would hopefully be done by Todd Yandow, with Mike assisting. It was voted to take down the old stair railing, and given to a gardener.

Herm informed the members that cremated occupants be put into permanent containers and burial only permitted by authorized personnel. He explained that graves will be covered safely at the time they are dug to avoid any accidents before the funerals.

Gloria will continue a project that Oscar Churchhill began with his son, relating to the mapping of stones and names to be recorded later for posterity.

Meeting adjourned at 8:45.
