

**MORRISVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES
April 6, 1999**

The Planning Commission discussed reactivating the known sub-committees for the grant administrator to work with (ie: Bike Path/River Walk Committee, Village Revitalization Committee, Growth Center Connector Committee). PM volunteered to contact the Downtown Group. It was decided that the Planning Commission would start contacting the committees and invite them to the April 20, 1999 meeting.

Sixth Order of Business:

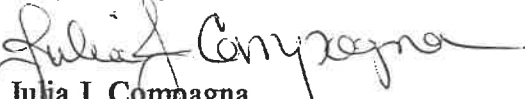
The Planning Commission reviewed the letter of concern being sent to the Agency of Transportation regarding the Route 100 Bypass/Bridge Street intersection.
