BOARD OF CIVIL AUTHORITY MEETING

The Board of Civil Authority of the Town of Morristown convened the warned meeting at the Town Clerk's Office in said town on Monday, the 3rd day of April, 2000, at 12:00 P.M.

Members present: Francis Favreau, Donald Anderson, Edward Wilson, Jane Greene, Theresa Breault, Kenneth Campbell, Margaret Lambert, Alan Deuso, Thomas Hirschak, Lee Sturtevant, Jim Paige, Paul Griswold and Mary Ann Wilson.

Listers present: Lynn Miller and Francis Favreau.

Chairman Favreau opened the meeting at 12:12 P.M.

Pursuant to Title 17 V.S.A., Section 2142, the board met to revise the checklists for the Annual Village Meeting of the Village of Morrisville to be held on Monday, April 10, 2000, and the Special Town School District Meeting of the Town of Morristown which will be held on Tuesday, April 11, 2000. It was moved by Don Anderson with a second by Peg Lambert to approve the additions and deletions as presented by the Town Clerk. All in favor and the motion carried. (See lists attached.)

Pursuant to Title 24 V.S.A., Section 1535, the board along with the Listers, met to consider abatement of real estate and personal property taxes assessed. Don Anderson moved to abate the Village taxes as presented by the Treasurer and Listers. (See attached list.) Motion seconded by Peg Lambert. During discussion Lee Sturtevant moved, with a second by Alan Deuso, to abate the list as presented **except** for the accounts of Peter Bourne and Chris Ransom who are each still in possession of the properties. Amendment voted affirmatively. Returning to the main motion as amended, the board voted unanimously in favor. The board instructed the Clerk to send letters informing Mr. Bourne and Mr. Ransom of the amounts due.

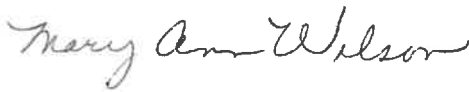
On a motion by Don Anderson with a second by Peg Lambert, the board voted to abate the amounts listed for the Town of Morristown as presented by the Treasurer and Listers. (See attached list.)

Pursuant to Title 17 V.S.A., Section 2150, the board begin the preliminary work to purge the voter checklist. Town Clerk Wilson submitted a list of challenged voters to aid in the process. Board members confirmed the validity of several voters. All others will be challenged according to the process for purging checklists.

Scheduling of B.C.A. members was set for the upcoming Annual Village Meeting and Town School District Meeting.

With no other business to come before the board, Donald Anderson moved for adjournment. Alan Deuso seconded the motion, and the motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 1:20 P.M.
