

**MORRISTOWN/MORRISVILLE
PLANNING COMMISSION
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Minutes of April 2, 2001

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM. by Stephen Jennings, Chair.

Kelly made a motion to approve the minutes of March 20, 2001 as written.
Julia seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

A form was sent to the Planning Commission that will be used for Alpine Snow Guards to be eligible for State financing to extend the municipal sewer line to the proposed lot in the Industrial District.

Julia made a motion to sign the letter that Alpine Snow Guards/LEDC say that industrial uses are allowed in the industrial district.

Bruce seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ken asked if the Planning Commission should consider holding a meeting on the airport as there is a lot of miss information out in the community. The Commission discussed if they should hold an airport meeting to clear up any confusion on the proposed airport extension. It was decided that the Town has no new information on the proposed airport extension from the AOT meeting last month and that noise is everyone's concern and until this data is available there is no practical reason for the Commission to hold a meeting.

Stormwater issues came up again as a concern and problem. Last week one developer was upset that he could not get an access permit unless he treated the stormwater from the new house and driveway on site, as there is already an existing stormwater problem on site and compounding the problem is unacceptable.

Ken told the Commission that in their packet is a notice on a stormwater seminar.

Julia made a motion to have Ken Sweetser and Bill Moulton to attend this seminar if possible.

Kelly seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Ken told the Board that Norwich University has decided against working on the Bridge Street/ Brooklyn Street and Upper Main Street/Park Street/Copley Avenue intersections. Dave Pelleteir, LCPC, Transportation Planner told Ken if we get him a letter request that they look at the two intersections he can put it in his plan of work. Ken is to draft letter for LCPC and Stephen will sign it on behalf of the Planning Commission.

Ken informed the Board that the number have dwindled off with a couple of the groups and suggest that we cancell our April 17th meeting and meet on April 18th with the Morristown Community Partnership. This was agreed upon by the Commission.

The Planning Commission discussed that we need to work closely with the other boards in town. The quarterly meet with the DRB can take place as soon as April 26, 2001. The Commission agreed to meet on April

26th with the DRB at 7:00 PM. They would like to invite the Select Board, Trustees, and Conservation Commission to see how we can all work together on planning issues and concerns, especially stormwater. Ken will send out agenda and cover letter.

Kelly made a motion to adjourn at 8:45 PM.
Bruce seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
