February 2018 meeting minutes were approved.

Old Business

- (1) **Tree Order Update-** trees will be shipped in April. Ron has ordered 50 Chestnut and 8 Apple trees.
- (2) **Mud Brook Stream Crossing-**Ron talked with Matt Marble, we need 2'x2'x8" rocks in the stream according to Walter's description.
- (3) **Clark Park-**Ron talked with Craig who said we could go ahead with the easement for Clark Park without waiting for the FERC license. Ron spoke with Tim Sargent who is working on a draft easement. The parcel would be divided into two pieces. Parcel A would include the eastern half of the parcel and the electric facilities; Parcel B would be on the west side of the bypass. Ron notified Dan L. that this was going on also.
- (4) **On April 17 VINS is talking at PA auditorium.** Ron will find out about the posters. Total cost is \$400. Dick will be back next week. This date conflicts with April MCC meeting but we will reschedule to the 18th.
- (5) **Ron attended Johnson Emerald Ash Borer meeting.** W&L was also told of the meeting. There will be a 4/27 meeting in Hyde Park.
- (6) **Ron went to the Planning Commission meeting** and said he was opposed to increasing the density of housing as proposed for Jersey Heights.
- (7) **Green-up is May 4th.** Jim will get the banner up. Brent will talk to LCPC about making a map. He will also order the dumpster. Ron will email Erica that MCC will do Green-up. We will discuss Green-up at the April 18 meeting.
- (8) **Brownsville, Stowe.** We should make a donation to the Stowe Land Trust as we have worked with them in the past. Brent made a motion to contribute \$1000. Kristen seconded it. Motion was approved unanimously.
