January 2015 meeting minutes were approved.

Members Report

Ron – met with the Select Board about the gate, the SB okayed the road reclassification. Bridge Street parking lot is a good idea according to the board. There are 2500 Ash trees in the Town excluding the village. Ron emailed Richard Tomlinson and asked him if we wanted to join the commission.

Jim-mentioned that the Lamoille NRCD was looking for partners to participate in their round table discussion on county natural resource issues. The Village Trustees and SB agreed to the 20,000 ft² threshold for the stormwater regulation. The Green Mt Arena discussion with the planning commission is Tuesday the 24th.

Dave – The GMA parcel has considerable conservations holdings with the VT Housing and Conservation Board. We need better explanation of the logging bill from Doug.

Brent- the best time to put in duck boxes in the wetland in the TF is now. Three to four boxes are needed. Brent and Dave will build them and be reimbursed by the Commission. A motion was made approving the disbursement of funds for the duck boxes.

New Business

75 copies of the Town Meeting questionnaire will be printed. The table and questionnaire will be in the Tegu Building. Steve will tabulate the results.

The construction of a new house in an established but cleared deer yard between Stage Coach Rd and Cochran Rd was discussed.

Old Business

Town Forest – Dave would like clarity on the invoice and where the \$1700 in income went and would like to see a clearer report. Dave and Brent talked to Doug about the basal damage to the trees. Doug will correct his practices and he will fill in the ruts in the spring. Fran is going to check on Doug.
