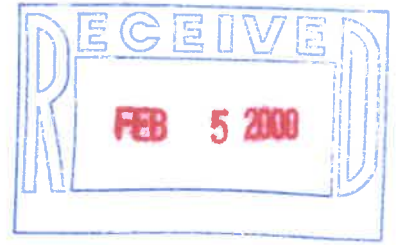


**MORRISVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES
February 1, 2000**

First Order of Business:

Ken Sweetser gave an update on the grant Paul Markowitz has been working under. Paul Markowitz and Ken will discuss a written agreement to go beyond the grant deadline. The Commission will follow up with this issue at the next meeting.

Second Order of Business:

Ken Sweetser gave an update on several planning issues identified in the Legislative Bulletin that are pending this session.

Seventh Order of Business:

The Commission discussed available "Downtown" grants.

Eighth Order of Business:

Ken Sweetser gave an update on the status of the Cadys Falls wellhead recharge area issues. A deadline of March 1, 2000 has been set to accept bids. The ad for bids will be published this week.

Ninth Order of Business:

Ken Sweetser gave an update on the status of the Route 100 Bypass. AOT wants to delete the catholic school access point. Both Ken and GR think it is important to oppose deleting this access point. The Commission agreed that they oppose the deletion of the access point at the catholic school. Ken Sweetser to draft a letter of opposition to AOT.

The Commission reviewed the meeting minutes of January 18, 2000.
SG moved and BT seconded a motion to approve the minutes as written.
