

MORRISTOWN/MORRISVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION
MEETING MINUTES OF JANUARY 21, 1997



Members Present: Bill Bourne, Rich Furlong, Jane Greene, Sam Guy, and George Robson.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Bill Bourne, Chairman. This meeting was scheduled to be a joint meeting with the Development Review Board members for the specific purpose of discussing the proposed Village Bylaws revision.

Paul Trudell stopped by to drop off his comments on the proposed changes to the Village Bylaws.

The Planning Commission had some more discussion regarding the recent rejection of the Planning Grant application for Morrisville Downtown Revitalization. Until all of the issues are resolved that were discussed at the January 7, 1997 Planning Commission meeting, no further action will be taken on this matter.

After a lengthy discussion of Village Bylaw 477 on Temporary Signs, the Planning Commission is recommending that this Bylaw be removed and administered by the Legislative Body of the Village.

Section 476. Illumination and Animation of Signs. Item B. of this section should permit Internally Illuminated signs only in the Central Business District of the Village.

The Planning Commission conducted a review of Paul Trudell's comments on the proposed changes to the Village Bylaws:

- . Section 415.1 - "Lots on Two Streets" should be changed to read "Lots on Multiple Streets".
- . Section 415.4 - remove the word "who" after Development Review Board.
- . Section 421. - remove "and non-affiliated" from the first sentence.
- . Page 68 of Definitions. Manufactured Home - Use only the first sentence and remove the remainder of the definition.

The Planning Commission meeting minutes of January 7, 1997 were reviewed and approved as written.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
